

About the Workshop

The institution caters not only to the academic needs of school education but co-curricular and vocational aspects as well. Given the growing focus in present times towards vocational education in secondary schools, it becomes imperative that skill development be a part of teacher education curriculum. Furthermore, there is an urgent need to contextualize the skill set to our own situation not just conducting training in skills that are of national importance. In addition, the state grows naturally vast species of herbs that could be tapped for making medicines and dyes. The Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE) has ventured to identify pashmina weaving and natural fabric dyeing as special skills for entrepreneurship.

India is rich in natural wealth and there is ample scope to explore and revive application of natural dyes on textiles. Kashmir valley abounds a rich source of biodiversity with a great wealth of natural products and natural dye yielding plants. Pashmina wool is a luxurious fibre used for making high quality fabrics. The Pashmina fabrics are dyed with natural colours for their further value addition. Revival of pashmina industry can be an alternative for the increasing number of unemployed in the state.

About the College

The institution started with a humble beginning as a Teachers Training School in 1937. It was upgraded to Teachers training college in 1948 and designated Govt. College of Education in 1968. The college rose to the status of Institute of Advanced Studies in Education in 2016 on the recommendation of MHRD team. At present the institution serves as School of Education under Cluster University Srinagar. The institution now aspires to be a Teacher Training University and is working hard in that direction. Being accredited by NAAC in 2004 and then re-accredited in 2011 (CGPA 3.52) with Grade A, both the times the peer team placed on record great appreciation and recommendation for up gradation of the status. The institution is the lead Teacher Training College being the only one in the valley and works hard to achieve its mission of Excellence in Teacher Education. Presently the Programmes offered are B.Ed (200 pre-service & 100 in-service) M.Ed Regular (60) M.Ed Supplementary (60) MA .Edu (30). The duration of all these courses is two years. The students are also provided an opportunity to choose any one among the offered 11 Certificate Courses which are add-on courses. Besides teaching the institution lays emphasis on extension services and training of both School Teachers and Assistant Professors of Higher Education Dept., Educational administrators, ZRPs, CRPs. The institute has linkage with DISC, SIE and DIET.
