The Higher Education Department, Govt. of J&K issued orders for up gradation in August 2016 vide Govt. Order No: HE/UP-GRAD/COES/CSS2013/78 Dated: 04/03/2016 wherein the college was upgraded to INSTITUTE OF ADVANCED STUDIES IN EDUCATION (IASE). In 2016 there was a change in the affiliating University, the college is presently affiliated to Cluster University Srinagar, and with its affiliation to Cluster University Srinagar it was designated as “School of Education”. The institution now aspires to be an autonomous University and has started working in that direction.
