The students namely **Syed Tahir** & **Salik ul islam** from class 10<sup>th</sup> deliberated their speech on Topics: **Floods in Kashmir & Earthquakes in Kashmir** respectively. Then Chief Guest of program gave introductory speech on the theme, he also talked about the need & importance of Sustainability Goals under G-20 Summit.

The Guest Lecture was delivered by **Prof. Aijaz Ahmad Dar**. In his talk he mentioned about the Disasters that had struck the Jammu & Kashmir region in 2005 & other natural disaster vulnerability of this region. He described how most parts of J&K fall under the high seismic zones IV & V making J&K vulnerable to earthquakes. He stressed on the necessary measures that we all should take in order to avoid loss of lives & property. He said, the unsuitable sites should not be used for settlements or any sort of construction as such areas are often prone to natural disaster like landslides or floods. The powerful earthquake of 7.8 magnitude rocked Turkey & Syria on February 6, leaving around 11,000 dead while thousands of buildings were toppled like a pack of cards. **"We need to learn lessons from such earthquakes,"** Prof. Aijaz Ahmad Dar said. The venue reverberated with the lively interactions of the keen teachers & students with the speaker.
